Day 1(23/3/2018): Active Surveillance for Tuberculosis

Nursing Interns along with MBBS Interns went to Bhagabatipur village for house hold survey of 50 known Tuberculosis case. Students collected spot sputum samples of five suspected cases for testing and detecting TB.

Day 2(24/3/2018): Mass Awareness Programme

Mass awareness programme was organized regarding control and prevention of Tuberculosis in Bhagabatipur village to increase awareness about different aspect of Tuberculosis, its care, prevention and its treatment. Fifty villagers attended the programme.



The programme began with speech delivered by Dr. Binod Patra, Additional Professor Department of CM & FM, AIIMS Bhubaneswar. Nursing Intern students performed a skit on the theme: showing sign and symptom, sample collection, treatment regimen and care of patient with tuberculosis followed by health education session. Feedback was taken from participants about the knowledge which they gained from mass awareness programme. At the end, refreshment was given to the children and villagers who attend the camp.

The sputum samples taken from 05 suspected cases were examined in the camp. Out of 5 suspects 02 were sputum positive for Tuberculosis. They were referred to CHC Mendhasal, for DOTS treatment.

Department of Community and Family Medicine: MR campaign in AIIMS BBSR:

MR vaccine was provided free of cost at the immunization clinic (Dept. of CM&FM) Room no: 24, Ground floor, OPD Block-C under the campaign w.e.f 29 Jan 2018 and continued till 6th April 2018. Total beneficiaries who received the MR vaccination were 339.

SENSITIZATION WORKSHOP ON ICD-10 FOR MEDICAL AND NURSING FACULTIES, RESIDENTS AND STAFFS OF AIIMS BHUBANESWAR

World TB day celebration in CHC Mendhasal:

On the occasion of “World TB Day” Department CMFM, AIIMS, BBSR in association with College of Nursing, AIIMS and CHC Mendhasal an effort was made to spread community awareness as well as to find missed cases in remote tribal village Bhagbatipur with high TB burden

Two days (23rd and 24th March) activities were conducted in Bhagbatipur tribal village. On 23rd March, all households were surveyed by interns of medical and nursing college AIIMS, BBSR for chronic cough (>14 days) and containers were provided to bring the morning sputum in the next day camp. Dr Priyamadhaba Behera (Senior Resident) and Mr Bubu (STS) made household-visit for all registered TB cases to ensure follow-up, compliance and appropriate counselling.

On the second day “TB awareness and sputum collection camp” was organised at Bhagbatipur anganwadi centre. Nursing students performed role-plays under the supervision of Miss Shayama Devi (asst. Prof.) Mrs Sujata Mohapatra (tutor) to raise awareness on importance of full course treatment and major do's and don'ts of tuberculosis. Dr Binod Kumar Patro (Add. Prof), Dr Manish Taywade (Asst. Prof) and Dr Priyamadhaba Behera interacted with community members about various methods to prevent TB and importance of completion of treatment in TB. “Sputum collection camp” was successfully completed with help of LT CHC Mendhasal and Dr Dinesh Prasad Sahu (Junior Resident).

1. Addition of new faculty to the Department: Four new faculty members have joined and two more are due to join the department. The department has consultants from multiple disciplines like 1) General surgery, 2) Medicine, 3) Pulmonary Medicine, 4) Anesthesia, 5) Maxillofacial, 6) Neurosurgery. Consultants from Plastic surgery and Orthopedics are due to join very soon. This makes the Department geared up to handle almost all patients of Trauma and Emergency.
2. Addition of ventilators: Three more ventilators have been added to the already existing two ventilators in the Emergency Department (ED). This has made it possible to provide ventilator services to more needful patients (please see table).
3. Due to lack of ICU beds, 33 sick patients were shifted from the wards to the ED from various disciplines during the last 3 months.
4. Addition of fluid warming cabinet: Intravenous fluids are kept warm, so that in emergency situation large amount of IV fluids can be infused without the patient being hypothermic.
5. Inspection for commencing MD degree in Emergency Medicine was done on 13th March.
6. Mass casualty /Disaster : Twenty-two patients of food poisoning were managed in the ED on 4th February night.
7. BLS course was conducted for 32 participants on 28th February.
8. Plaster room and minor procedure room was inaugurated

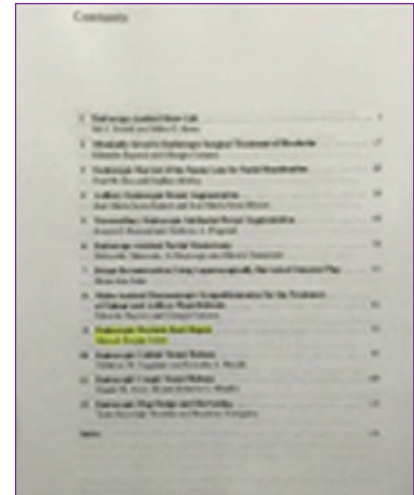
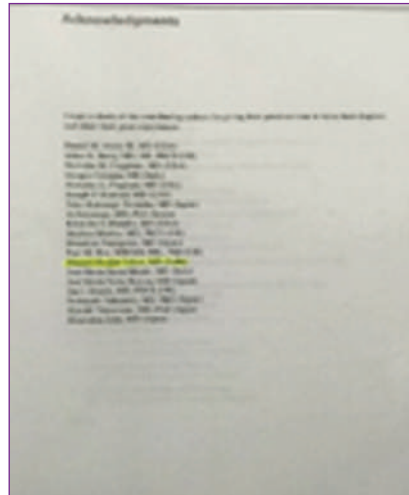
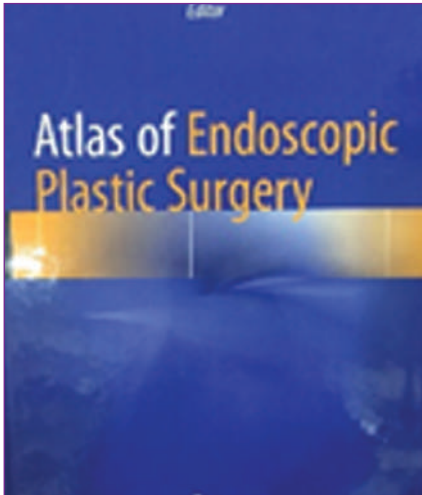
