

Postgraduate: Master of Science (Nursing)

M.Sc Nursing is a two years duration which includes classroom learning and clinical experience in respective specialties.

Students are required to submit a dissertation in partial fulfilment of the program. Students are given experience in education and administration by organizing conferences or workshops.

Note

For Indian Nationals, a 5% reservation for a person with benchmark disability shall be provided on a horizontal basis, in the seat available in M.Sc. Nursing courses. The eligibility criterion for candidates under this category as per the guidelines finalized by the Nursing Council of India as amended from time to time.

NOTE

- On selection, the candidate will be allotted to the institute based on the choice made by the student during the counselling. On confirmation of joining AIIMS Bhubaneswar after counselling rounds, the student shall be provisional admitted to the course on payment of the fee decided by the Institute.
- Any student, preferring a choice of other AIIMS during the subsequent rounds of counselling may pay the fees through Demand draft. Accordingly, on joining the institute of choice and confirmation of admission to the institute, the DD paid at AIIMS Bhubaneswar will be refunded to the candidate.
