

Undergraduate Courses: B.Sc (Hons) Nursing

B.Sc (Hons) Nursing is a Four-year duration course including six months of integrated practice. The course includes classroom learning and practical sessions. The medium of instruction is English.

A total of 75 candidates are admitted through the national entrance exam conducted by the All-India Institute of Medical Sciences, Delhi.

NOTE (On selection) :

On selection, the candidate will be allotted to the institute based on the choice made by the student during the counselling. On confirmation of joining AIIMS Bhubaneswar after counselling rounds, the student shall be provisional admitted to the course on payment of the fee decided by the Institute.

Any student, preferring a choice of other AIIMS during the subsequent rounds of counselling may pay the fees through Demand draft. Accordingly, on joining the institute of choice and confirmation of admission to the institute, the DD paid at AIIMS Bhubaneswar will be refunded to the candidate.

In case the candidate discontinues the course after completion of all rounds of counselling and the admission process, the student will have to pay a penalty as per the institutional policy.

Mess is compulsory for Nursing students residing in the hostels. The mess charges are subject to revision from time to time payable to the outsourced vendor every month in advance.

The candidates taking admission under the category have to produce a valid caste/EWS certificate to that effect.

The students taking seats under PwBD (persons with benchmark disability) have to produce the valid proof of certificate for approval by the committee at AIIMS Bhubaneswar.

After provisional admission, students will have to submit the Genuineness certificate from the respective boards for the 10th and 12th standards as well as the medical fitness certificate from the medical board of AIIMS Bhubaneswar for completion of admission approval.

All students shall submit an undertaking for not indulging in ragging throughout the course.

On completion of the course the candidate shall register the qualification under the Odisha Nurses and Midwife Council and National Registry Tracking System.
