- I. The above vacancies are provisional and subject to variation. The Director, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar reserves the right to vary the vacancies including reserved vacancies as per the Govt. of India rules/circulars and requirements.
 - II. Out of four Assistant Professor posts in Community Med.& Family Medicine, one post is reserved for Biostatistics and one post for Clinical Epidemiology.
 - III. Age and all other qualifications will be counted as on last date of receipt of application.
 - IV. The period of experience wherever prescribed shall be counted after obtaining the prescribed qualification.

DETAILS

- (A) APPLICATION PROCESS:** Advertisement and Application form is hosted at www.aiimsbhubaneswar.edu.in. Application form can be downloaded from www.aiimsbhubaneswar.edu.in and www.mohfw.nic.in, and filled online at www.aiimsbhubaneswar.edu.in. The printed copy of the on-line application and the attested photocopies of all relevant certificates along with the originals must be brought at the time of interview. The on-line filling up of application form will start on **29th June 2013** and will automatically close on **29th July 2013 at 5.00PM**.
- (B) APPLICATION FEE:** The application fees of Rs. 1000/- (Rs.300 for SC/ST candidates) to be made by means of a Demand Draft drawn in favor of AIIMS Bhubaneswar payable at Bhubaneswar or payment can be made on-line/NEFT. Other Instruments of payment may be used, Account details: Bank of India, AIIMS Bhubaneswar Branch, Account No **557820110000006**, IFSC code **BKID0005578**. This fee once remitted will not be refunded.
- (C) FROM OTHER INSTITUTES:** Those who are working in Central/State Government /Semi Government Autonomous body have to submit "No Objection Certificate" from their respective organization along with their application.
- (D) ANNEXURES:** Attested photocopies of Degrees, Certificates, Mark sheets, Age proof, Caste certificates etc. may be annexed to the hard copy of the application to be produced in original along with photocopy for verification at the time of interview.
- (E) AGE LIMIT:** Age limit should not exceed 50 years for Assistant Professor and Associate Professor and 58 years for Additional Professor and Professor. Age is relaxable for Government servants, SC, ST and OBC up to 5 years and in otherwise exceptionally qualified/deserving cases.

(F) SHORT LISTING: Based on bio-data, the Selection Committee may short-list candidates for interview. Candidates called for interview will have to produce all relevant original documents in proof of details furnished in their application at the time of interview.

(G) SITE OF INTERVIEW: The interview will be held at AIIMS, Bhubaneswar. No TA/DA will be paid for appearing in the interview.

(H) ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS

- a) For medical specialty, a medical qualification included in the first or second schedule or Part II of the third schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act of 1956 (persons possessing qualifications included in Part II of the third schedule should also fulfill the conditions specified in sub section (3) of the Section 13 of the Act.).
- b) For dentistry, a recognized Dental qualifications included in Part I or Part III of the Schedule to the Dentist Act, 1948 (persons possessing qualifications included in Part I or Part III of Schedule should also fulfill the conditions specified in sub section (1) and (2) or (4) of Section 10 of the Dentist Act, 1948).
- c) *PhD or Equivalent in the Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology, Microbiology, Pathology, Biostatistics and Clinical Epidemiology recognized in India for non medical candidates with 3 years' post Doctorate fellow teaching experience.
- d) The candidate must be registered with the state/Central Medical/Dental Council of India.

- a) **Professor:** 13 years of Teaching/Research Experience after Qualifying degree (3 years as senior resident or equivalent + 10 years as faculty).
- b) **Additional Professor:** 9 years of Teaching/Research Experience after Qualifying degree (3 years as senior resident or equivalent + 6 years as faculty).
- c) **Associate Professor:** 6 years of Teaching/Research Experience after Qualifying degree (3 years as senior resident or equivalent + 3 years as faculty).
- d) **Assistant Professor:** 3 years of Teaching/Research Experience after Qualifying degree or 3 years as Senior Resident or equivalent.
- e) **For Super specialists:** 3 years pre MCh/DM degree residency will be counted as teaching experience.

(J) PAY SCALE

- a) **Professor: Pay Band-4:** Rs.37400-67000 with Academic Grade Pay of Rs.10500 (Plus NPA for medically qualified candidates only) with the minimum pay of Rs.51600/- and AGP of Rs.10500/-. Plus usual allowances admissible to equivalent posts in Government of India. Up to 40% of posts of Professors will get Higher Administrative (HAG) scale subject to clearance of the prescribed process.
- b) **Additional Professor: Pay Band-4:** Rs.37400-67000 with Academic Grade Pay of Rs.9500 (Plus NPA for medically qualified candidates only) with minimum Pay being Rs.46000/- and AGP of Rs.9500/-. Plus usual allowances admissible to equivalent posts in Government of India.
- c) **Associate Professor: Pay Band-4:** Rs.37400-67000 with Academic Grade Pay of Rs.9000 (Plus NPA for medically qualified candidates only).) with minimum Pay being Rs.42800/- and AGP of Rs.9000/-. Plus usual allowances admissible to equivalent posts in Government of India.
- d) **Assistant Professor: Pay Band-3:** Rs.15600-39100 with Grade Pay of Rs.8000 with a minimum of Rs.30, 000/- + NPA. (NPA for medically qualified candidates only) with provision to move to PB-4 after three years (Rs.37400-6700) with Grade Pay of Rs.8700/-.
